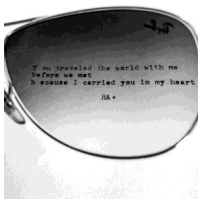




Year 11 English Curriculum

Term	Curriculum content
Michaelmas 1 	English Language Paper 2: Viewpoints and Perspectives and Power and Conflict poems -The Identify Cluster Pupils study a range of non-fiction texts and learn how to analyse and evaluate writer's viewpoints on various topics. They will also learn how to write preservative letters, speeches and articles on a range of topics. Pupils then study the 5 identity poems which are: <i>-Checking Out Me History by John Agard</i> <i>-Kamikaze by Beatrice Garland</i> <i>-Poppies by Jane Weir</i> <i>-The Emigree by Carol Rumens</i> <i>-Tissue by Imtiaz Dharker</i>
Michaelmas 2 	Unseen Poetry-Literature Paper 2 The reading and analysis of a range of diverse poems. This prepares pupils for the final element of the GCSE Literature 2 exam which is unseen poetry.
Lent 1 	Revision and Recap of: An Inspector Calls Jekyll and Hyde Macbeth
Lent 2 	Revision and Recap of: English Language paper 1 and paper 2
Trinity 1 	Final revision of all topics At this stage, teachers work to prioritise the main areas of need for their classes. We do weekly exam questions in timed conditions and ensure we are recapping and revising all topics continuously.
