Grammar: the verb ‘estar’ and ‘ser’ to be in the present tense and negative, adjectival agreements. Skills: Describing how we are feeling and why using justification phrases. Unit 2 – Eres deportista – Are you sporty? Topic: Talking about if we are sporty, what sports we do and play and giving opinions. Grammar: The verb ‘to play’ and ‘to do’. Skills: Extending your sentences with varied conjunctions and giving the opinions of other people.
Michaelmas 2	Unit 3: En mi móvil - On my phone Topic: Talking about activities we like to do on your phone Grammar: Me gusta + infinitive and intensifiers Skills: Giving extended opinions and justifications. ASSESSMENT: Receptive Skills: Dictation (spelling), listening, reading Production Skills: Translation into French, Extending Writing Unit 4: Prefieres ir al cine o ver la televisión - Do you prefer to go to the cinema or watch TV?

	Topic: Talking about our preferences about cinema and TV Grammar: comparative adjectives, infinitives, near future tense Skills: Giving opinions and using the near future tense
Trinity 1	Module – Las relaciones (Relationships) Unit 1 - Cuántas personas en tu familia? How many people in your family? Topic: Describing personalities of our friends and family. Grammar: the verb ‘ser’ to be, revisiting adjectival agreements Skills: Using the verb ser in different pronouns to extend our answers Unit 2 – Te llevas bien con tus amigos/ tu familia? - Do you get along with your friends / your family? Topic: Describing our relationship with friends and family. Grammar: Reflexive verbs, using “que” and a variety of the verb ‘ser’ (to be)
Trinity 2	ASSESSMENT: Receptive Skills: Dictation (spelling), listening, reading Production Skills: Translation into French, Extending Writing Unit 3 - Cómo eres y cómo es tu amigo? Topic: Describing ourselves and our friends. Grammar: The verb ‘tener’ to have and the position of adjectives Skills: Extending our answers by talking about different people using first- and third-person pronoun Unit 4: Qué te gusta hacer? Topic: Talking about what we like to do in our free time.
