CONTEXT – URBAN ENVIRONMENTS

Timed Test – 10 hours under exam conditions.



1. New Buildings.

Construction sites are interesting and busy places in the urban environment. Significant building projects are ongoing in Lewisham. Use photography as a starting point to generate a final piece using construction as a theme.

2. Journey.

Many artists have recorded their own personal journey travelling through a particular place. Consider a local place that has meaning to you and record your journey from start to finish.

3. Opposites.

It is often said that a busy city thrives on extremes of wealth, power, age, status, environment, and moods. Investigate a theme incorporating a binary opposite into a final piece.

4. Architectural detailing.

Classical buildings have clear architectural features are purely decorative. Use these details to develop your own response that could include perspective drawing.

5. People at work.

The busy nature of a city is often shown by people travelling to and from work. This could be by car, rail or by foot. Investigate these ideas and produce a final piece that could include movement, action and energy.

6. Looking up.

Often artists look at everyday places in different ways to catch the viewers' attention. Select a building and use photography to look at the ceiling in different ways.
