## Year 11 Post 16 Activities:

- **Blackheath High School** came in to speak to a group of year 11 pupils about their post 16 offer. Blackheath High is an independent girl's school with an all-girls Sixth Form offering a bespoke Sixth Form curriculum including 25 different A-level subjects alongside the Extended Project qualification. Pupils also learned more about the scholarship and bursary opportunities on offer and were invited to attend their up-coming open evening.
- **Haberdashers' Knights Academy Sixth Form** visited Trinity to speak to our year 11 pupils. Haberdashers' Knights offers a range of Level 3 subjects including A Levels, BTECs and a CTECH. As well as speaking about their post 16 offer and the Haberdashers' Company Scholarship opportunities, Mr Cole also spoke about the success of Trinity students who have previously studied at Haberdashers' Knights. Keren and Esther, two trinitarians who joined Haberdashers' Knights this year also spoke about their sixth form experiences.
- **Colfe's School** came to Trinity to speak to a group of our year 11 pupils about their post 16 offer. Colfe's School is a local co-educational independent school with a high achieving sixth form offering a range of A Level Subjects and BTEC Sports and Exercise Science. As well as post 16 subjects, pupils learned more about sixth form life at Colfe's, the range of extra curricula activities available and the scholarship and bursary opportunities on offer. The presentation was followed by an engaging Q&A session with former Trinitarian and current Colfe's Sixth Form head boy Kirabo, who himself achieved a scholarship to study his A Levels at Colfe's.

- All pupils should be choosing the subject(s) and qualifications they want to study and where they want to study after year 11.
- Researching schools, colleges, and training providers that offer the course(s) or subjects they want to study.
- Attending many open events - these are great opportunities to explore schools or colleges and find out more about the courses on offer and ask any questions you may have.
- Applying to their chosen 6<sup>th</sup> Forms or Colleges. We recommend pupils apply to at least five different post 16 destinations, so they have a range of options on GCSE results day. Pupils must check the entry requirements for their chosen course, making sure they have a backup plan.
