Year 9 Assessment Week Timetable

Dear Trinity Families,

Year 9 students have now begun their GCSE options and have had substantial time to deepen their knowledge and understanding in their selected subjects. As a result, they will undertake their first formal assessments of the academic year. Assessment week for Year 9 will commence on Monday, 9th March 2026, and conclude on Friday, 11th March 2026.

These assessments provide Year 9 students with the opportunity to demonstrate the knowledge and skills they have acquired throughout the term. Additionally, this is an excellent chance for pupils to become accustomed to the expectations and processes involved in formal assessments.

In the lead-up to assessment, subject teachers will guide pupils towards a range of revision materials. Students are encouraged to make full use of these resources during their half-term break to ensure they are thoroughly prepared. At home, pupils should focus on writing revision notes, creating flash cards, reviewing classwork, and utilising their booklets to test their understanding.

During the Assessment Week, pupils should attend school promptly with all the necessary equipment in a pencil case, including a calculator. It is crucial that the highest standards of behaviour, attendance and punctuality are met during the Assessment period. Please ensure your child is well-prepared and fully equipped for their assessments.

These assessment results will be shared with parents/carers alongside the termly report at the end of this term in April, which will also include updates on behaviour and attitude towards learning.

A reminder that all Year 9 Pupils will be attending a performance of Romeo and Juliet at the Globe Theatre on Wednesday 11th of March. This falls in the middle of assessment week and as a result the Option D assessment slot has changed. The Music Technology assessment will be sat on the **4th March** whilst Citizenship, Photography, Statistics, Business and Triple Science will be sat on the **18th March**.
