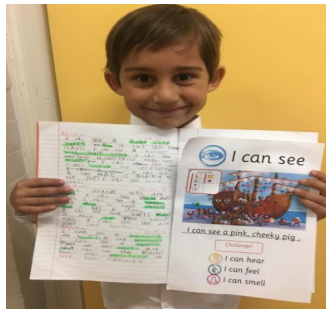
Welcome Back!

We have been learning new songs, counting and most importantly making new friends

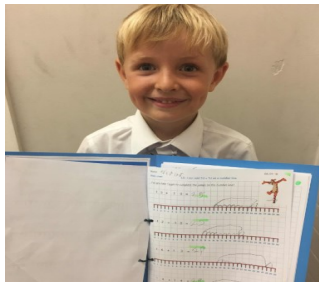
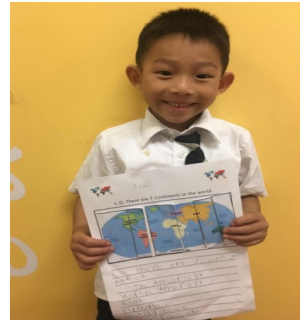


It has been a fantastic first week at the Primary Phase and the children have jumped straight back into their learning.



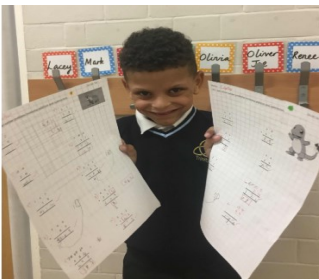
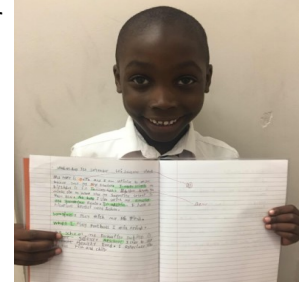
In Year 1 the children have been reading the book 'Pirates Love Underpants' and producing some phenomenal writing about different scenes from the book.

They have been also looking at ways to improve their writing by using a wide range of sentence openers. What an impressive start to Upper Key Stage 1!



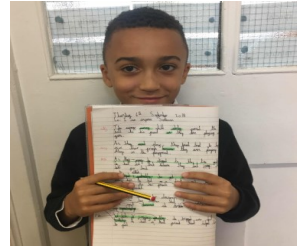
In Year 3 the children have been having a go at some really tricky column additions and subtractions. Even though it has been a real challenge, like true Trinitarians, they haven't given up!

They have also started their art topic off with a bang by recapping primary colours and experimenting with what colours and patterns they could make using just them alone.



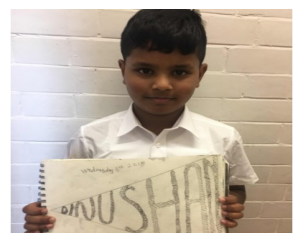
Year 4 are loving their new whole class reading text, Matilda! They were all very excited to receive their own copy and have already decided that Matilda is a pretty awesome role model!
