As ever, I wish you the very best of weekends full of rest and fun, ready for learning on Monday.

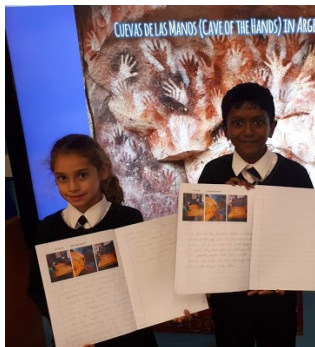

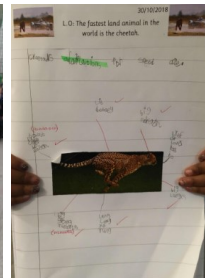
Stone Age Painting in Year Three

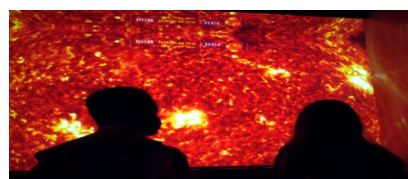
Black History Month: Rosa Parks
