Dear Trinity families,

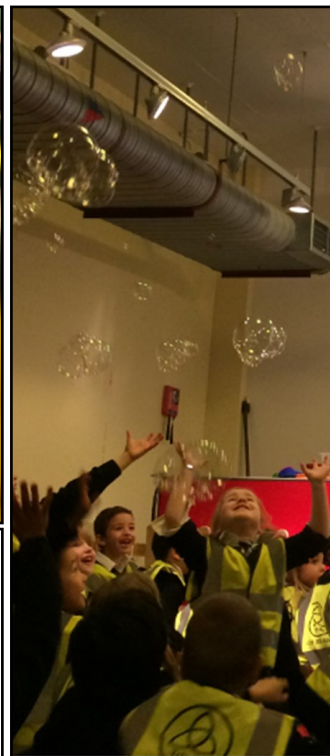
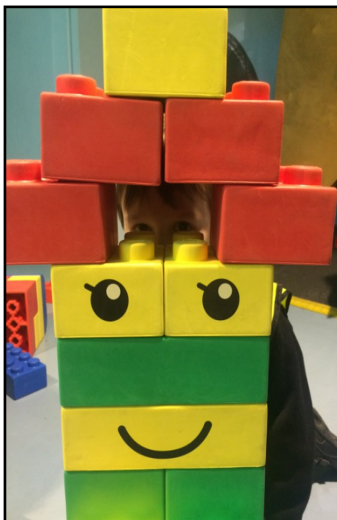
