Notes from the Parent Forum:

Thank you to everyone who attended the Parent Forum at the end of last half term. Below is a brief summary of discussions:

- Confirmation that the school day will end at 3:30pm as of September
- Confirmation that we are seeking wraparound care providers to begin in September
- Common consensus was that the wraparound care provider should only cater for Trinity pupils unless there were no providers offering that service
- A letter appealing for resources for Reception classes will go out soon, detailing items we feel can be sourced from the local community at low cost and enhance learning experiences
- Confirmation that the school will be using a 'cashless' payment system called Parentpay for trips and lunch money as of September (details of which will be given before the end of term)
- Parents agreed that clarification over what can/cannot be included in packed lunches for trips and during lunchtimes is needed. This will be provided in a newsletter in the coming weeks.
