The next academic year is almost upon us and we would like to share with you teachers and staffing arrangements for next year.

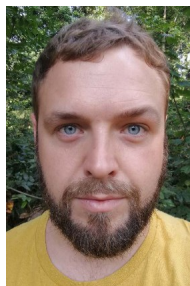

New Teaching Staff
